In the Caribbean Sea, the Caracoles and Garifuna await you on Guanaja and Chachahuate, some of the most isolated islands in Honduras. These locals are welcoming PONANT in a completely new way, allowing us to observe their daily life and traditions. During his scouting of these unspoiled 'true gems', José Sarica, our Expedition Experience Director, made lasting connections with these communities, hence the unbridled access. At other latitudes, Zanzibar, Madagascar, and the Mascarenes, or Vanuatu, New Caledonia, and French Polynesia conjure up images of fascinating encounters and landscapes that simulate all of our senses.
