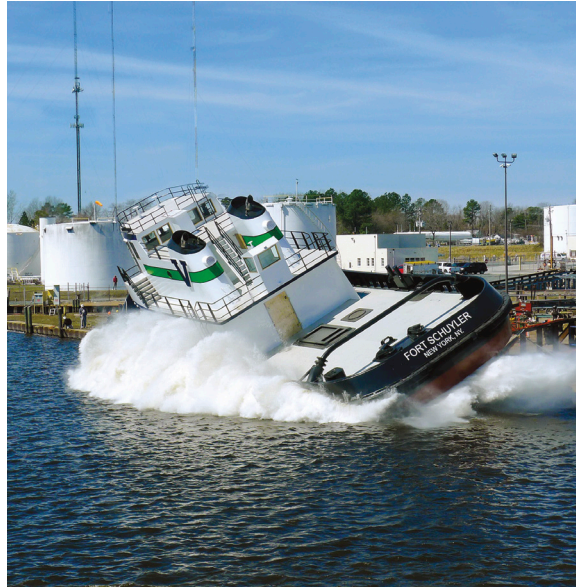
Each new ship begins at Chesapeake Shipbuilding with our team of in-house naval architects and marine engineers. The ships are designed in the U.S. for operation in the U.S., including compliance with U.S. regulations and vessel specifications that match the operating region.

Chesapeake then begins the vessel construction in Salisbury, MD. Steel is sourced from U.S. manufacturers, primarily in Alabama and Pennsylvania. Engines and generators are from a host of American names, including Caterpillar, John Deere, and Cummins, and the list of U.S. parts goes on. The men and women at the yard bring all these pieces together to create each ship.

Once built, the ship becomes one of very few cruise ships that is truly American. It is registered in the U.S. and flies the American flag at the stern, where ships display their nation's flag.

Our dedicated all-American crewmembers bring the ship to life and share our interest in exploring the U.S. Many of the crew have sailed with us for years, while others are looking for an adventure as they define their careers. Over the course of a year, we travel to a host of American ports – more than 150 towns in 35 states. From the lines in the design lab to the steel in the yard and the smiles of our crew, **we are American.**

**Departure Ports:** All departure ports are located near major airports. Transportation between the airport and ship may be available for an additional charge. Parking is available at all departure locations at nearby commercial garages or lots at a reasonable weekly rate.

**Departure Times:** Cruises depart at 1:30 p.m. or earlier if all passengers have arrived. Passengers may board after 11:30 a.m. Crew members will carry your luggage to your stateroom. Passengers are recommended to arrive no later than 12:30 p.m. Cruises sometimes return the evening before the last day of the cruise, and passengers may stay on board until 8:30 a.m. on the last day. Breakfast is served on the last day of every cruise.

**All-American:** American Cruise Lines offers a unique experience that emphasizes the history and culture of the United States. American Cruise Lines is an American company and operates ships which are built and registered in the United States. Additionally, all crew members and employees are Americans.

**Reservations:** Reservations should be made as far in advance as possible to ensure the availability of the cruise and stateroom choice.

**Fare:** American Cruise Lines, Inc.'s per person fare includes passage, dining service, snacks, complimentary cocktail parties, and entertainment aboard the ship.
