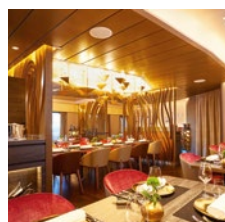
SPORTS CLUB

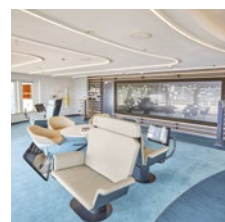


OCEAN SPA

A light-filled spa and sauna area covering 215 m² (2,314 ft²), plus 25 m² (269 ft²) of outdoor space with a view of the open sea.

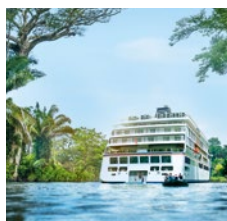

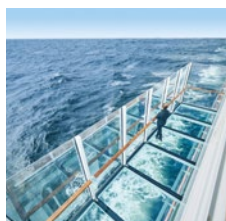

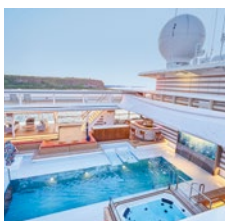
MARINA

The marina is the convenient starting point for a variety of activities such as swimming, stand-up paddling or snorkelling.



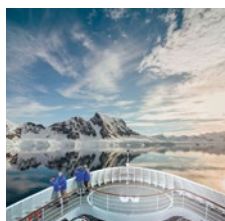
GLASS BALCONIES
